The share of Gujarat state in the country's GDP in the year 2023will be Rs. 22,03, 062 crore has been estimated. Thus, the contribution of the state to the economic development of the country is seen more. This paper is presented to study how much expenditure is spent on the tourism sector of Gujarat state and how much revenue the state receives through tourism. Excluding the period of Covid-19, the state's expenditure on the tourism sector is low. The state has increased expenditure for the development of the tourism industry under several programmes. And the expenditure is expected to increase in the coming years as well. And in future, the state will get more revenue from the tourism sector. So that the development of the state and the nation will be strengthened.

- Capital Expenditure = Capital Expenditure expenditure is incurred for the development of the Gujarat Tourism Sector. In future, the Government will receive revenue from Gujarat Tourism Sector which is included in Capital Expenditure.

Similarly, the Revenue Receipts of the Gujarat Tourism Sector in the years 2019, 2020and 2021were Rs 93. 37crore, 329. 8crores and 88. 75crores. Similarly, the percentage change of Revenue Receipts of Gujarat's Tourism Sector from 2019to 2021was 80%, 72% and -272% respectively. Thus, the investigation here shows that the percentage change in 2018 and 2021 was negative.



Thus, an examination here shows that the percentage change was negative in the years 2018, 2019and 2021.



Thus, on examination here it is found that the percentage change was negative in the years 2018and 2020.



